FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear CSI Seaford Family,

I greet you all in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

December is a special month for the Church. It is a time of waiting, preparing, and celebrating. As we enter the season of Advent, we remind ourselves that Christmas is not only a historical celebration of the birth of Jesus, but also a time to reflect on His coming into our lives today and His promised second coming.

Advent means coming or arrival. During these weeks before Christmas, we remember how the people of Israel waited for the Messiah with hope and faith. They lived in difficult times, yet they held on to God's promises. In the same way, Advent invites us to wait with hope. It reminds us that God is always faithful, even when the world around us feels uncertain.

Advent invites us to imagine a new world. That new world begins when Christ rules our hearts. The coming of Jesus—past, present, and future—reminds us that God is near, God is with us, and God will come again.

May this season help us experience Emmanuel—God with us. May we celebrate Christmas not only as a festive event, but as a spiritual renewal. And may we live each day with hope, waiting for the glorious return of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Wishing all our families a blessed Advent and a Christ-filled Christmas.
